Suggestions for the Final EE 4BI6 Report

- The report is due latest April 28 either in my office or in my mail slot but do try to get them in earlier if possible so I won't have to read all of them in one day.
- The report should have an introduction (why you are doing this project, background references or information could come straight from your proposal)
- There should be a final system description (block diagram with specifications or descriptions of each block again use the proposal information or diagram but this time updated to the final version with details)
- There should be a results section showing signals acquired, screen displays, etc
- There should be a discussion section with subsections on other approaches investigated with why rejected, difficulties encountered and overcome, suggestions for future improvement or alternate approaches that could be investigated.
- Appendices should be included showing detailed circuits, code, etc.
- Use pictures, graphs, etc to show results, circuits and system.
- There is no page limit but remember, clarity and brevity, not to mention good organization will be recognized and rewarded.
- Overall page count should be kept to under or around 20 pages, not counting appendices and references.
